Our Principles for Responsible AI Use

When using AI technologies, Equitable Growth is committed to:

- Protecting confidential, proprietary, and personally identifiable information.
- Maintaining human oversight of AI-generated outputs.
- Wherever possible, crediting original human authorship for their writing, research, and data.
- Reviewing AI-generated content for accuracy, quality, and relevance before it is used or published.
- Evaluating potential bias, fairness, and trust implications associated with AI tools and outputs.
- Complying with applicable privacy, data protection, and security requirements.
- Using AI only in ways that support our mission and organizational values.

Human Accountability

AI tools assist our staff but do not replace human judgment. Decisions, publications, research findings, communications, and other organizational outputs remain the responsibility of Equitable Growth staff and leadership. All AI-generated content is reviewed by our team prior to use.

Data Privacy and Security

We take appropriate measures to safeguard sensitive information. Equitable Growth does not share confidential, proprietary, privileged, or personally identifiable information with public AI tools without appropriate protections, approvals, and security controls in place.

Commitment to Equity and Inclusion

Because AI systems can reflect or amplify bias present in their training data, we remain attentive to issues of equity, fairness, and inclusion. We continuously evaluate the technologies we use to ensure they align with our organizational values and mission.

Ongoing Review

AI technologies continue to evolve rapidly. We periodically review our practices and policies to ensure our use of AI remains responsible, secure, and aligned with emerging best practices.
